SIGHT FOR STUDENTS

Serving students who may be in need of vision correction

In Cooperation with local school nurses and the National School Nurses Association, children from families who qualify, may be allowed to receive a free eye exam and glasses from participating eye doctors in a program called, "Sight for Students". The school nurse and the school counselor will work with individual families and verify if the requirements have been met.

Information provided will be kept confidential and will not be given to any other agency. If qualifications are met, a certificate will be provided for a free eye exam along with a list and contact information of participating doctors. The parent may then make an appointment with the doctor of choice and take the certificate to show the doctor's receptionist.

QUALIFICATIONS TO APPLY

Please note that you do not qualify if:

- You cannot provide a Social Security Number
- If you have Medicaid or other vision insurance
- If your household income exceeds Federal subsidy guidelines
